#### **ABOUT**

Horizon Europe has launched five Missions for Research and Innovation, aimed at increasing the effectiveness of EU funding by pursuing clearly identified wide objectives, addressing some of the greatest challenges of our time. Horizon Europe Missions also aspire to mobilize additional resources at European, national and local levels, to connect activities between different disciplines and different sectors, and to make it easier for citizens to understand the value of investments in R&I.

Each of the five Missions includes a portfolio of actions - research projects, policy measures or even legislative initiatives - aimed at achieving, within a pre-established time frame, an ambitious, measurable and socially relevant objective, which could not be achieved through single actions.

Among these EU Missions, the **Mission Cancer** is oriented at **improving the lives of more** than 3 million people by 2030 through prevention, cure and for those affected by cancer including their families, to live longer and better. In particular, 4 are the areas of intervention, all closely interconnected: (1) understanding, (2) prevention, including screening and early detection, (3) diagnosis and treatment, and (4) quality of life.

Apart from Horizon Europe, the Mission Cancer will benefit significantly from other EU funding programmes. In particular, synergies are expected with the **EU4Health** programme, especially contributing with its budget in the development and roll-out of the network of Comprehensive Cancer Infrastructures, as well as in the actions for the European Cancer Patient Digital Centre, towards a European Health Data Space.

Such synergies between Horizon Europe and the EU4Health programme will be more and more evident with the implementation of the Work Programme of the Mission Cancer, where new proposals under both programmes, could count on a critical mass of exploitable results!
