Join us for an in-depth webinar organised by HNN 3.0 and tailored specifically for CL1 NCPs. This session will provide a comprehensive overview of EIT Health, its role within the EIT KIC framework, and the opportunities it offers for organisations active in health research and innovation.

The webinar will guide participants through the mission, structure, and thematic priorities of EIT Health, highlighting its connection with Horizon Europe, covering also eligibility criteria, including who can apply, participation rules, and country coverage.

Participants will receive an overview of the most relevant open and upcoming calls and funding streams for actors in the health field, along with practical explanations of composition consortium requirements, partnership roles, and geographical considerations.

The session will also cover membership options within the KIC, detailing types of membership, associated benefits, and when membership is mandatory for participation. A dedicated segment will focus on proposal preparation, addressing evaluation criteria and key lessons learned from previous calls. It will be also outlined the budgeting framework, funding rates, co-funding requirements, and eligible costs.

Attendees will be guided through the submission and selection process, including timelines, evaluation steps, and the degree of flexibility allowed after submission. To support successful project implementation, we will describe monitoring and reporting obligations, as well as the support available from EIT Health and NCPs.

Finally, the webinar will present practical tools and resources for applicants—partner search platforms, brokerage opportunities, tips for newcomers, and advisory services—to help organisations strengthen their proposals and build effective collaborations.
